braille points are stamped from the bottom of the plate. In addition to braille information for the blind, we laser mark inscriptions for the visually impaired. Bending is performed individually after specifying the diameter of the handrail. The overlay is glued from the bottom with a very strong double-sided adhesive tape, which effectively prevents the plate from detaching from the handrail. Minimum order 10 pcs.
